

MINUTES OF MAWNAN PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON THURS. 20TH JAN'11 IN THE MEMORIAL HALL

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

A. ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

1. Cllr Dearnley declared a personal interest in planning application PA10/08583 for Penwarne Barton Farm

B. OF GIFTS TO A VALUE OF MORE THAN £25. No declarations

3. TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM THE POLICE Read by the Chairman

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE AGENDA. None.

5. TO CONFIRM MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING on 16TH Dec'10. It was proposed by Cllr **MB**, seconded by Cllr **NG** and RESOLVED that the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on 16th Dec'10 be approved as a true record and be duly signed.

6. AGENDA ITEMS

A. TO DISCUSS THE PUBLIC TOILETS. The paper on the Public Toilet Referendum was noted. It was proposed by Cllr **MD**, seconded by Cllr **BL** and RESOLVED that the toilets, excluding the disabled toilets, be closed from Sept.30th –Good Friday, and that the Council would seek volunteers in the summer to survey their actual usage before any further action was taken.

B. TO UPDATE COUNCIL ON PUBLIC DISCUSSIONS ON HOW THE PARISH MAY WISH TO CELEBRATE THE ROYAL WEDDING ON APRIL 29TH'11.

Standing Orders were suspended to allow discussions on the report back to the Parish Council on the meeting to discuss the Royal Wedding. The arrangements received general approval. Cllr **BL** agreed to be the Parish Council's representative on the planning committee in place of the Chairman. It was

proposed by Cllr **DG**, seconded by Cllr **MB** and RESOLVED that the Parish Council contribute £1,000 to help stage the events.

C. TO DISCUSS THE ALLOTMENTS. Standing Orders were suspended to allow the NT rep, John O'Donohue to say that he was willing to take over the arrangements for calling a meeting of all interested parties. Agreed. He would receive all the paperwork for the project and report back to the Council at the February meeting.

D. TO DISCUSS "THE GREAT POPPY PARTY". To celebrate the 90th birthday of the Royal British Legion. It was felt that neither the Council nor the village would be in a position of organising such an event with the close proximity of the Royal Wedding. The information would be given to Major Hibbert at Trebah

E. TO AGREE TENDER DOCUMENTS FOR GRASS CUTTING & TOILET CLEANING. It was proposed by Cllr **MD**, seconded by Cllr **AL** and RESOLVED that the contracts be the same as previously, except that the cleaning of the toilets contract be changed to reflect the closing dates.

F. TO DISCUSS NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANS AND LOCALISM BILL. Councillors were advised to keep up to date with changes that are discussed in parliament.

G. TO DISCUSS F.O.I. REQUEST. Cllr **Dr.DG** read out a letter from Mr Jermyn who was requesting financial information under the FOI.

The Chairman read out a draft response from the Parish Council. Proposed by Cllr **MD**, seconded by Cllr **RS** and resolved that the letter should be sent to Mr Jermyn.

8. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

A. TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED FROM CORNWALL COUNCIL:-PA10/08583 RETENTION OF 2 CARAVANS AT PENWARNE BARTON FARM. P

Proposed by Cllr. **DG** and seconded by Cllr **BL** and resolved that Mawnan Parish Council strongly objected to this application and requested that Cornwall Council takes swift enforcement action against the continued use of these caravans in the AONB. One letter of objection was also received.

9. FINANCE AND PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS. The accounts having been checked by Cllr **MD**, it was proposed by Cllr **MD**, seconded by Cllr **RS** and RESOLVED that the Accounts be accepted.
