E. UP-DATE ON TRAINING DAY FOR USE OF SALT BINS attended by Dr **DG** & CC N Hatton. A useful, instructive day. Parish Councils are not legally responsible for clearing the highways but are legally responsible for clearing snow from the properties they own. Sand mixed with salt for the bins has been purchased by the Parish Council for £165. This sum was ratified by the Council.
