1.TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT FOR CLERK. It was proposed by Cllr Sadler, seconded by Cllr Dearnley and RESOLVED that Cllr Miss King act as temporary replacement for the Clerk for the duration of the meeting.

B. TO DISCUSS EMERGENCY PLANS FOR THE WINTER MONTHS, Ideas for discussion include: Place a notice on the notice-board, inviting names of vulnerable people to be given to the Clerk. An appeal on Mawnan's web-site, requesting neighbours to keep an eye on one another. Salt bins to be in place as soon as possible. It was proposed by Cllr Gartside, seconded by Cllr Sadler and RESOLVED that these measures be introduced.

C. TO RECEIVE UPDATE FROM THE CHAIRMAN ON THE COST IMPLICATIONS OF THE PUBLIC TOILETS. The resolution to place a 10p pay machine in the toilet doors to measure the usage of the facility was not practicable, so to make an informed decision on its closure, a letter to the public asking for their opinions, would be drafted by **Dr DG**, for approval at the next meeting.

D. TO NOMINATE A COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE RENDLESHAM TRUST. It was proposed by Cllr Gartside, seconded by Cllr Sadler and RESOLVED that former councillor, Mr Richard South should continue as the Council's representative on the Rendlesham Trust.

E. TO DISCUSS THE CONSULTATION DOCUMENT FROM CORNWALL COUNCIL ON AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT. Cllr NG highlighted all the points in this document. It was proposed by Cllr Dearnley, seconded by Cllr Gartside and RESOLVED to send a letter of general support, articulating issues of local concerns. Cllr Sadler abstained from voting.

F. TO CONSIDER A S137 GRANT REQUEST FROM THE NEWLY FORMED HELFORD RIVER CUBS. A letter with the Group's Accounts was presented from Mrs JT. It was proposed by Cllr Rex Sadler, seconded by Cllr Nigel Gilmore and RESOLVED that the Group be awarded £150

G. TO DISCUSS POSITIONING OF PLANTERS REMOVED FROM THE MCA

Now that the planters have been tidied up by Dr **DG**, it was agreed that if no alternative site could be found, they would be returned to their original position in the Spring, subject to the donors approval.
