## **627/05 TO REPORT MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES NOT ON THE AGENDA**

Councillor Gartside said that he had attended a site meeting at Little in Sight with Cornwall Council West Area Planning Viewing Panel. Members of the panel agreed that they would apply a condition that a soak away be constructed about half way up the site. He said that Cornwall Council Planning Panel came and held a site visit due to the objections put forward by the Parish Council. He said that he had represented the Council at a pre-application planning meeting at Anvower, this enabled him to articulate the concerns of the Parish Council. The planning application for Chyverton has been withdrawn due to a site visit whereby it was agreed that the proposed property was too large for the site and contained too much glass within the design.

**632/05 FINANCE AND PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS**

**a) Payment of Accounts**

**633/05 REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES AND REPRESENTATIVES**

**a) Police Report**

PCSO Huddlestone reported that there had been 1 reported crime in the parish. This was an allegation of assault as a result of a tenant landlord disagreement and is currently under investigation. There were no calls to the police about antisocial behaviour. The vehicle at Penwarne discussed at the last meeting has been removed. PCSO Huddlestone is organising Junior road safety officers at the school with a view to conducting some speed awareness days in the new year.

**b) Footpaths**

Cllr Mrs Loomes said that she has received enquiries regarding the estimated completion of the work on footpath 19, she advised that it would be completed in the spring when the weather and ground conditions have improved. She has also erected a notice at the Calidnack Lane end of footpath 10 advising that the mud is deep and slippery. It was agreed that Councillor O'Dell will have a look at the footpath with a view to improving the footpath surface. Councillor O'Dell said that he would organise a meeting with the contractor
