Allotments update

Cllrs Mrs Beth Lawry and the Allotments Group are in discussion with County Farms about the possible use of land immediately behind the MCA Hall, at Carwinion Playing Fields. If this is able to go ahead, then there would be room for 14 allotments, and water would be available onsite

Speed Visor update

The proposed Variable Message Sign (Speed Visor) for Grove Hill, near to the Shute Hill junction, is near the stage of final go-ahead, and should be installed well before the end of the financial year. Anvil Trust / Chy-An-Scol

The Parish Council and the Anvil Trust are investigating the possibility of obtaining grant finding to allow the purchase of the old blacksmith's house, alongside the Smithy. Various possible uses are being explored, including the possible conversion of the garage to form another unit, use of the downstairs area as a café and tea garden, and use of the upstairs are a reading room, internet café, or even possibly as accommodation for themed holiday breaks.

New Footpaths Guide – Available early July

Copies of the second version of the guide are now in very short supply, and a new print run is being undertaken in time for the busy holiday period. Copies will be available in local shops and hotels, as in previous years.
