MAWNAN FUN RUN

The 2017 Mawnan Fun Run was the most successful yet, with nearly 300 runnerstakingpartinthe 1 mile fun run and 5k and 10k races, and the event raised £2000 for Falmouth Rotary Club charities. This year the whole village joined in and various local organisations ran fund-raising stalls and attractions to make it a great community event. In recognition of the fantastic support received from members of the village community the Rotary Club will donate up to 50% of the sum raised to youth organisations and charities within the Parish of Mawnan by offering small grants.

Organisations can apply for a maximum of £250 to fund a specific trip, event, activity or piece of equipment and it is hoped that a number of different small projects will be supported.
