**2526.234 TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES**

**2526.235 MEMBERS TO DECLARE ANY INTERESTS IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA OR REQUEST DISPENSATIONS**

All Cllrs requested a dispensation because they are discussing items which have an impact on or are on behalf of the Mawnan Junior Playing Field Trust. All Cllrs collectively make up the Trust so have an interest.

**Proposing Mason, Seconded Potter, Resolved to approve all dispensations to stand in every parish council meeting until the May Parish Council AGM. All in favour.**

**2526.237 CIL APPLICATION MATCH FUNDING**

To consider submitting an Expression of Interest application for CIL grant funding to support improvements at the Junior Playing Field (Mawnan Park), agree actions and associated expenditure.

Cllrs received the recommendation from the Office and Finance committee:

***Cllr Moyle Proposed, Seconded Cllr Potter, Resolved that the office and finance committee have had a useful meeting and the figures voted on at the previous full council meeting on 17th February 2026 are achievable and recommend to the full council meeting the original vote stands. All in favour.***

Cllr Potter states despite voting for the resolution at the last parish council meeting he believed he was conducting the vote without Cllr Biggin being able to vote. He therefore recalls the vote tied at 2-2 with one abstain. Cllr Shepherd agrees. Other councillors and the clerk recall that there wasn't a decision made about Cllr Biggin's ability to vote and the meeting ended with a question mark over whether the vote was 2-3 (in favour) with one abstention (because Cllr Biggin did state at the time of her vote that if she was allowed to vote she would vote in favour).

**Cllr Mason proposed, Seconded Cllr Stabbins, RESOLVED that in accordance with the recommendation of the office and finance committee, the original decision of the PC meeting held on the 17th February is appropriate and that**

the council delegates to the clerk and Cllr Biggin to submit the expression of interest to the CIL fund. Eight Cllrs voted for, Cllr Shepherd voted against and Cllr Potter abstained.
